5 ENROLMENT

You will be sent an email containing instructions on how and when to complete your enrolment which will all be completed online.

You will receive an induction timetable at enrolment which will contain a variety of activities to help you settle in to College life such as getting to know staff, how to get around the campus and meeting your fellow class mates.

- One-to-one reviews with your academic tutor to ensure you are progressing and achieving well.
