UCC2 Bus Service 2024-25

As we look ahead to the new academic year, we begin the process of reviewing the bus services managed by the College.

The UCC2 service is currently operated by Nesbitt's Coaches Ltd. As always, the decision on whether the service continues for another year, depends solely on the level of interest from parents. Unfortunately, over recent years the number of students using the UCC2, has been steadily declining, so at this time, there is no guarantee that the service will continue.

To decide on the viability of the route and confirm back to you as soon as possible, we would be pleased if you could complete the form (using the link below), to register your interest in a place for your child/ren from September 2024.

Both the College and bus companies always strive to keep the cost to a minimum but for you to make an informed decision, the cost next year is estimated to be in the region of £1,500 per child. We are unable to clarity the exact amount until confirmed numbers are known. If your child is a current user of this service, you will note a significant increase from this year. This is due to ever increasing overheads which the bus company unfortunately needs to pass on.

The form will open at 6pm on Thursday 18th April and close at midday on Tuesday 30th April.

Please remember to complete the form for each child requiring a place.

If the level of interest confirms that the service is viable, the exact cost and the UCC Terms & Conditions will be sent along with an offer letter requesting a non-refundable deposit to be paid before the end of the summer term. Details of an instalment plan and a 'pay-in-full' discount will also be provided. Any requests for permits to be used on specific days or AM/PM only, will be considered if there remains capacity on the bus.

If, however, the level of interest shows the service not to be viable, sadly, the service will cease at the end of this year. I appreciate this would be very unwelcomed news, but we hope by notifying of a decision as soon as possible, it will allow plenty of time for alternative travel arrangements to be made.
