I look forward to meeting you and your family at our open evening. In the meantime, please take the time to explore our website www.uppinghamcollege.org.uk

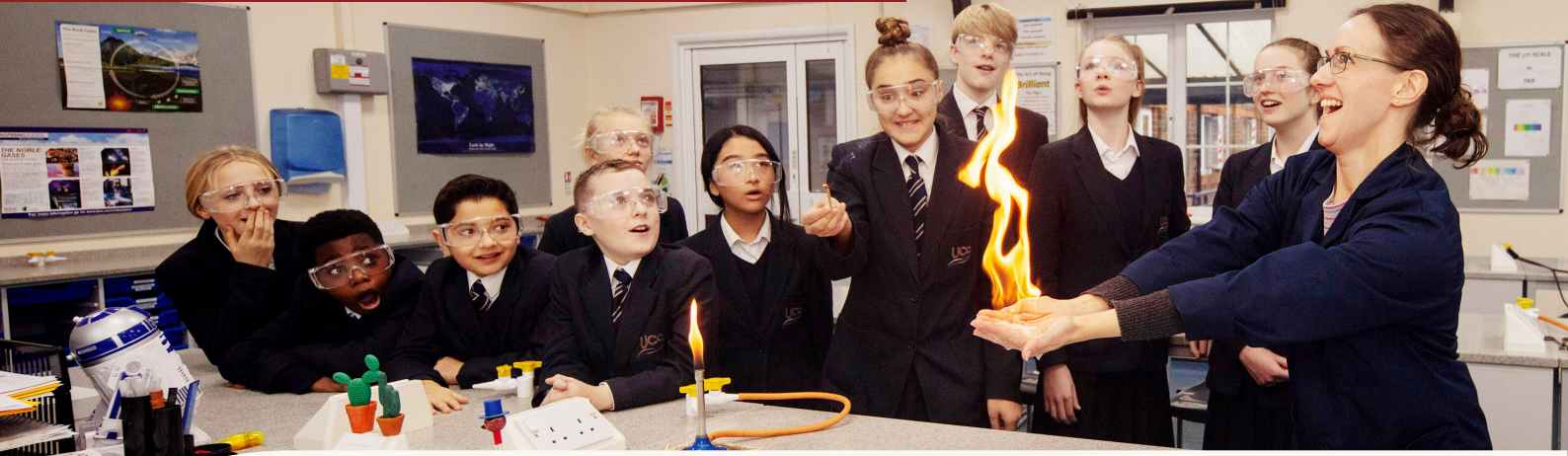

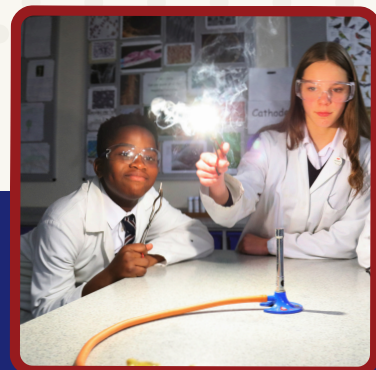
