### **UCC4 Bus Service 2026-27**

As we look ahead to the new academic year, we begin the process of reviewing transport arrangements and in particular, the bus services operated by the College.

The UCC4 service is currently operated by Lawson's of Corby Ltd and hopefully, depending on the level of interest, this service will continue for 2026-27.

For the College to confirm the viability of the route, we would be pleased if you could complete the form (using the link below), to register your interest in a place on this service for your child/ren next academic year.

**The form will open at 6pm on Friday 1st May and close at midday on Tuesday 12th May.**

Please remember to complete the form for **each child** requiring a place.

The UCC4 service has been extremely popular in recent years and often oversubscribed, so as places are limited; they will be allocated on a first come, first served basis to those requiring full time travel. Any requests for permits to be used on specific days or AM/PM only, will be considered if there is capacity on the bus but please detail this in the appropriate section on the form.

We always strive to keep the cost down and recognise there are other financial pressures that families face, although this year we have increasing global fuel prices to take into consideration as well. Once we have a good idea of interest and accurate numbers are known, we will be able to confirm the cost, however as an indication, it is expected to be between £1,350 - £1,450.

Further communication will be sent to confirm if a place has been allocated in the coming weeks. This will also include the exact cost, the UCC Terms & Conditions and a request for a non-refundable deposit to be paid before the end of the summer term. Details of an instalment plan and a 'pay-in-full' discount will also be provided.

The College reserves the right to immediately withdraw the travel permit should payments not be received or kept up to date.
