



## INSTRUMENTS OFFERED AT UCC

UCC offers lessons for a variety of instruments including:

- **Woodwind:** Flute, Clarinet, Saxophone,
- **Brass:** Cornet, Trumpet, Euphonium, Baritone, Tuba, Trombone
- **Strings:** Violin, Viola, 'Cello, Double Bass, Spanish Guitar
- **Percussion:** Drum Kit, Tuned Percussion
- **Keyboard:** Piano, Keyboard
- **Guitar:** Acoustic, Electric, Ukulele, Cuban Tres
- **Other:** Vocals, Recorder, Music Theory

If you're interested in a different instrument, UCC can help find a suitable teacher.



## LESSON DETAILS

- **Lessons per Year:** 33 lessons of 20 or 30 minutes.
- **Term Times:** Vary each term depending on teacher availability.
- **Lesson Arrangement:** Held during school hours on a rota basis. Students must check their timetable for lesson times.



## FEES & PAYMENTS

- **Cost:** Varies by teacher (approx. £12 per 20-minute lesson).
- **Payment:** Made directly to the teacher, in advance. UCC does not handle payments.
- **Materials:** Students must purchase their own sheet music, or it may be provided by the teacher (extra charges may apply).




## MISSED LESSONS & CANCELLATIONS

- Lessons missed by students will still be charged.
- If a teacher cancels, the lesson will be rescheduled.
- Notify teachers of absences (e.g. trips, appointments) at least 2 weeks in advance.



## FINANCIAL SUPPORT

- Support *may* be available for families receiving universal credit (up to 50% of lesson fees).



## INSTRUMENT OWNERSHIP & ENSEMBLE PARTICIPATION

- Students must own their instrument, with insurance responsibility falling on parents.
- Participation in school ensembles is encouraged once students reach an appropriate standard.



## SIGNING UP

- To sign up, fill out UCC Instrumental Tuition AGREEMENT FORM 2026\_27 and return it to Student Services.

- **Ensembles:** UCC offers a variety of ensembles including the UCC Stars Orchestra, Dukes of Uke Group, UCC Stars Choir and RockschooL.
- **Commitment:** Learning an instrument requires dedication from both students and parents.
