As part of our ongoing commitment to high-quality teaching and learning, we are excited to introduce a new educational tool that will be used for KS4 homework: [Learn Anything](#). This AI-powered platform is designed to support both students and teachers by offering immediate, personalised feedback, while also teaching students how to use modern technologies responsibly and effectively.

How Learn Anything will support students

Learn Anything will be used primarily to assist with marking written work and short-answer questions. It provides feedback to students almost instantly and highlights areas for improvement based on their specific response. However, teachers remain fully involved in the marking process. All AI-generated feedback is reviewed by the teacher, and final grades, comments and assessments are decided by a human professional.

The AI acts as a first-draft assistant - giving students quicker feedback - but it does not replace teacher judgement or oversight. This hybrid approach means students benefit from faster feedback and more opportunities to improve their work, while teachers retain full control over the learning journey.

A safe and focused learning tool

We want to reassure you that Learn Anything has been designed with clear boundaries:

- The AI only responds to academic prompts and stays strictly on topic
- It does not engage in off-topic or casual conversation
- If a student attempts to misuse the system (for example, by asking it to complete work dishonestly or initiating inappropriate chat), the platform alerts the teacher immediately
- Teachers can see all AI interactions and will continue to guide students in how to use these tools responsibly

Preparing students for future learning

To use AI well is becoming a vital skill not just for school, but for life beyond it. With guidance, students will learn how to use tools like Learn Anything to improve their thinking, reflect on their progress and become more independent learners.

Accessing Learn Anything

To help students get started with the platform, student guidance on how to log in and access Learn Anything is attached separately with this letter. The guidance includes an overview of logging in for the first time. We encourage parents and carers to review this information with their child to ensure they can access the platform successfully and begin using it for their homework.
