

Culture Year 8	Curriculum Intent: In year 8 our culture students follow a bespoke curriculum where we delve into and explore different countries around the world and their cultures. They experience foods from each country, working on their descriptive language to express their opinions.
	Weeks 1-39
Module	Students study a variety of countries: Australia, Brazil, Canada, Egypt, France, Germany, Greece, Iceland, India, Japan, Morocco, New Zealand, Scotland, South Africa, South Korea, Ukraine
Interleaving	Reuse of key vocabulary and concepts
Knowledge	For each country we explore festivals, key information, landmarks, language, wildlife, outfits, famous people, what you can do and food and drink
Understanding	Students develop an understanding of what makes up a culture and begin to make links between different cultures. They understand the concept of indigenous people and the effect of colonization.
Skills	Students develop the transferable skills of analysis, memory, tolerance, resilience and communication. They also work on their literacy and ability to work independently.
Assessment	A quiz after each country and a scrapbook which showcases an info page, festival research and food tasting opinions for each country.
