

Find a good place to study:

- Comfortable

Plan out a study timetable:

- Put in school first
- Then add in any extra curricular clubs / jobs
- Leave room to increase study time later in the year
- Make sure you include "down time"













3. Tackle the devices

Encourage and help organisation
