An opportunity for students to take part in the extremely popular Senior School Ski Trip which includes:

Overnight coach to Wagrain in the Austrian Alps where we ski Sunday – Friday with full tuition for 5 hours per day. All students are supervised by a qualified ski instructor in groups of no more than 12 (usually on average there are 10 per group). Students are grouped according to ability. Unfortunately, students cannot be permitted to ski without an instructor and there are no exceptions.

In the evening a full programme of après-ski activities will be offered which will include activities such as ice skating, pizza night, swimming, indoor sports, snow-party, to name a few. We are booked into the Jugendhotel Wurzenrainer, a superb hotel aimed at young people which we have used for the last five years, with fantastic facilities including a sports hall, an interactive zone, bowling alley and indoor trampolines in the village of Wagrain. The hotel is located a short bus ride from the ski lift and within walking distance of the village. Wagrain is part of Austria's 'ski paradise' the Ski Amade ski area, with over 270 lifts and 760km of pistes with a fantastic variety of runs to suit all abilities.

Oversubscription (42 spaces available): In the event of oversubscription priority will be given to students who have not yet had the opportunity to attend a UCC Ski trip. Names will then be pulled out of a hat. Deposits will be refunded to those who have been unsuccessful and these students will be put on a reserve list. Please note: if behaviour and attitude to learning has not been at least good during their time at UCC then it will be decided that these students may not attend the trip.		
The deposit is non-refundable once a place has been allocated and there may be additional charges applicable for cancellation for any reason before the trip date. By paying a deposit you are agreeing to adhere to the payment schedule

If you are unable to book using this service, please contact Student Services to discuss an alternative means of booking **before the deadline date**. Any delay could result in your child not getting a place.
