An opportunity for students to take part in the Modern Foreign Language trip to explore the capital of France.

We would depart Monday morning and return Friday night, travelling by coach and ferry.

Whilst in Paris excursions include visiting Montmartre and Place du Tertre, the Eiffel Tower, the Champs Elysées and Arc de Triomphe; an interactive backstage experience at le Grand Rex cinema; a cruise along the river Seine; ice cream at Berthillon on ile Saint Louis; exploring Parc Buttes-chaumont; a visit to Versailles including cycling round the gardens and a full day at Parc Astérix. Accommodation is in a modern hotel just on the outskirts of Paris. Such an experience would clearly be an ideal opportunity for your son/daughter to experience first-hand the life, culture and language of France.

The cost is **£515** per student, which includes travel, all excursions, accommodation, food (except lunch) and full insurance – it does not however include any spending money or lunches.

There are 44 places places available. If we are oversubscribed, names will be drawn out of a hat and a waiting list established.
