Consultation on Uppingham Community College Admission Arrangements for September 2021

Following our consultation period between 18th October and 29th November 2019 we received a number of pieces of feedback about our proposed changes mainly referring to the fact that those who live in the current/past catchment villages of our feeder primaries but do not attend feeder primaries would potentially miss out on a place at their closest school. In discussion with our governing body we have made some changes to our proposed admission arrangements for 2021 and we would like to send these out to make you aware of the now potential changes.

In summary, the **changes** (in green) relate to criteria 4 and 5 of the current admission arrangements, we propose they change to:

Those attending the following primary schools or living in one of our catchment villages (please see appendix
1)

Bringhurst Primary, Billesdon C of E, Church Langton C of E, Cottingham C of E, Edith Weston Academy, Gretton Primary Academy, Hallaton CofE, Leighfield Academy, St Mary & St John CofE: North Luffenham, Tugby CofE, and Uppingham CofE.

Removal of the term 'catchment area'. Our current admission policy states that:

4. Those living in the catchment areas of, or attending the following primary schools:

Bringhurst Primary, Edith Weston Academy, Gretton Primary Academy, Hallaton CofE, Leighfield Academy, St Mary & St John CofE: North Luffenham, Tugby CofE, and Uppingham CofE.

5. Those attending the following primary schools:

Billesdon C of E, Cottingham CofE or Church Langton CofE.

We will extend our consultation period to 20th January 2020.
