

French Year 9 (dual linguists)	<p>Curriculum Intent: In year 9, dual language students will study 3 areas pertinent to their life which also link into the GCSE content. They will focus on understanding and expressing previous, current and future events, actualities and intentions. Grammatical knowledge will be built upon from Y8 with key structures to each topic, such as expressing hopes, alongside a more in depth knowledge of various past, future and conditional tenses. Continual skill development will occur through the inclusion of the four key areas of listening, speaking, reading and writing. Students will make links between these areas to develop their understanding of how languages work. A range of skills within these key areas will be developed throughout each unit with repeated practice. Each assessment will be used to inform future learning in the next unit, allowing teachers to focus on areas of knowledge and understanding which may need more practice.</p>
